### Shiraz Ex Oppido Uitsig

2021, Constantia, South Africa

Full bodied with freshly crushed black pepper and violets. Layers of plum and black cherry with undertones of liquorice, vanilla and cedar, framed by firm tannins.

### Tempranillo Psi Bodegas y Vinedos Alnardo

£73.00

2020, Ribera del Duero, Spain

Intense ruby colour and vibrant on the palate. Concentrated dark berry flavours and a hint of coffee and spice, this is from master winemaker Peter Sisseck who brought Pingus to fame. A project designed to revive areas of gnarly old vines which had been almost abandoned by their owners. Full bodied and fabulous with steak or venison.

### Chateauneuf-du-Pape Cuvee Tradition Vignobles Gonnet

2021, Rhone, France

Organically grown Grenache (70%), Syrah (10%) and Mourvedre (10%) plus a smattering of other local grapes have been handpicked to produce this rich, dark, brambly red full of Christmas cake spices, liquorice and nutmeg notes. A full bodied, concentrated wine.

### Chateau Lagrange a Pomerol, Etablissement JP Moueix

£88.00

2016, Pomerol, Bordeaux, France

Inky in colour, rich and plump with velvety smooth tannins. 95% Merlot, 5% Cabernet Franc. Classically tailored to be enjoyed now and many years in the future. Dark juicy, berry fruits and a wonderful, long finish. Fabulous with beef, lamb and game.

### Othello Dominus Estate

2014, Napa Valley, USA

Napa Cabernet blend in the hands of Moueix is a wonderful thing. The combination of refined elegance, rich fruit and smooth tannins is sensational. Dark cassis and plum with notes of black olive and spice. Smooth tannins and best enjoyed with hearty red meat dishes.

### Barolo La Tartufaia DOCG Giulia Negri

From a wonderfully talented young winemaker, this is the product of two very specific sites Serradenari (the highest point in Barolo) and the Brunate vineyard. ## Sparkling Wine & Prosecco

**Fagher Prosecco DOCG Le Colture Brut NV** £8.50 £45.00

Veneto, Italy

Crisp citrus with notes of freshly baked bread followed by a vibrant palate and with lower sugar levels than a standard prosecco this lends itself to food pairing as well as aperitif material.

**Cremant de Jura, Blanc de Blancs, Tisso Lemaire NV** - £47.00

Jura, France

Made exclusively from Chardonnay grapes and using the 'traditional method.' A rich creamy texture, vibrant acidity and moreish brioche character.

## Champagne

**Delamotte Brut NV, Le Mesnil-sur-Ogier** £12.00 £65.00

Champagne, France

One of the oldest Champagne houses, Delamotte's wines remain hand crafted and of fantastic quality. The high proportion of Grand Cru Chardonnay grapes gives this non-vintage blend a lovely balance of fresh, well-rounded rich fruit and floral notes.

**Delamotte Rosé Brut NV** - £98.00

Champagne, France

Finesse and elegance are synonymous with Delamotte, one of Champagne's most respected names. Delamotte Rosé is all elegance and finesse with appealing wild strawberry fruit.

**Pol Roger NV** - £85.00

Champagne, Epernay, France

A blend of the three Champagne grapes in equal measure. Powerful on the nose with the pear and mango then floral notes of jasmine and honeysuckle. Cooked stone fruit on the palate and a touch of spice on the end.

**Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut NV** - £140.00

Champagne, France

A sense of indulgence and of course romance. Made from 100% Pinot Noir grapes, this wine has fresh raspberry, redcurrant and brioche aromas and a sense of nobility about it. Wonderful with seafood.

**Dom Perignon Brut Vintage** - £375.00

2012, Champagne, Epernay, France

Floral with rhubarb and mint on the nose and a touch of white pepper. The palate explodes in a burst of ginger, tobacco and roasted nuts.

## Dessert Wines

**Chateau Briatte** £8.00 £40.00

2018, Sauternes, France

Enticingly aromatic and floral nose on the nose then tropical fruit here, melon and lychee with traces of honey. Chilled, it works beautifully with rich savoury dishes as well as cheeses and desserts. This little property neighbours the illustrious Chateau d'Yquem and Suduiraut estates.

**Oreg Kiraly Dulo Sweet Szamorodni Furmint** £9.50 -

2019, Barta, Tokaji, Hungary

A stunning dessert wine from the village of Mad, in the Tokaji region of Hungary. Caramelised hazelnuts, dried apricots and candied citrus on the nose and fresh pineapple, marmalade and dulce de leche on the palate, with a fine seam of acidity running through. Bold and exciting.

## Isle of Skye Gin

### Misty Isle

£4.50

Our premium house gin made locally in Portree with water from the Storr Loch and hand foraged juniper berries from around Skye, you can visit their shop while in town.

### Misty Isle Pink

£4.80

Pear, blackcurrants and meadowsweet with raspberries infused all harvested from the distillery garden on the Isle of Skye.

### Misty Isle Sweet & Salty

£4.80

This superb Skye gin is carefully handcrafted and distilled with sea orache that is gathered from the shores of Loch Portree. Locally sourced juniper, homegrown coriander seeds, angelica root, blueberries and meadowsweet stalks.

### Misty Isle Tommy's

£4.80

Tommy's Gin was created in memory of Tommy Wilson, the distillery owners late father who served in the British Army during the Suez crisis. 'Tommy' is also a generic name and term of endearment for a soldier, so it was very fitting to them to name it Tommy's. Poppy seed, juniper, coriander, liquorice root, blaeberry, sweet orange.

### Misty Isle Mulled Spiced - Please note this is seasonal

A festive favourite with a range of botanicals including juniper, cassia bark, star anise and tonka beans, all of which are soaked in a rich Italian Amarone red wine.

### Skye Gin (The Storr)

Made by the award-winning Skye brewery over in Uig, juniper, rose hip, coriander, sweet peel, black peppercorn, orris root, liquorice root, heather, locally sourced wild angelica & meadowsweet.

### Uisge Lusach Dry

£5.60

From the south of Skye comes this truly small batch bottling, distilled by Leah Dunlop at Pràban na Linne. This gin is packed with spice, complemented with a hit of citrus.

### Wild Skye Sloe Gin
